Travel

- Valid Passport 3 months validity after you exit Schengen zone
- Schengen Enough balance of 90 days in 180 day rolling period
- Valid GHIC/EHIC cord
- Travel Trip Insurance (high cost cancellation £4.4K per person!)
- Mobile phone roaming package (if not included) / install WhatsApp
- Ferry Pay
- Bank/Travel Card (activate new cards!)

- Bike service
- Tires / Brakes / Chain + Sprocket / Fluids / need to last 5000 miles
- Insurance is covered for all counties incl. transit
- Tell your insurance company and check fully comprehensive outside UK
- Breakdown / recovery back to the UK
- Driving licence / V5C / UK sticker
- Spare Keys
- Tools / Pressure gauge / puncture repair / pump / chain lube if applicable
- Sat Nav / Paper map
- Heated grips (not a nice to have!)









What to Take & Wear - 22 Days!

- Riding
 - 4 Season Riding Gear
 - Comfortable Helmet
 - Extra External Waterproof Layer
 - Gloves for every weather (scorchio monsoon)
 - Thermal layer / base layer / t shirts / warm layer / warm & cool socks
 - Earplugs / Spare glasses / Intercom
- Clothes
 - Evening Smart casual 2 3 mix and match outfits / coat/fleece.
 - 10 sets underwear/socks
 - Trainers or Boots
- Laundry
 - Minimise clothes, wash and dry on heated floors/bathrooms
 - Microfibre towel /washing line / laundry detergent
- Other
 - Water Bottle
 - Sun Screen / Insect repellent
 - First Aid / Medications (incl. over the counter, expensive and may not be accessible available) Immodium was a popular team medication.
 - Cameras / Electronics / Leads / Converters / Chargers
 - Storm bag / bungee cords (e.g. 30L)

A Years Riding in 3 weeks

- Checks and preparation reduces risk especially in isolated areas
- Check / grease chain regularly
- Check tyre pressures daily if no sensors big temperature variations
- Check tread, roads are excellent but a course/grippy surface
- You build up a lot of insect residue! Take a cleaner/cloth
- Keep your phone charged

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Law


- Ride on the right
- Give way to the right
- Speed Limits

Built up areas 25-31mph | Main roads 50mph | Motorways 56 mph

- Speed Cameras forward facing (Blue signs)
- Rural police presence is very low
- Alcohol 0.02% BAC (UK is 0.08%) Minimum €5,783 fine

Roads

- High quality road surface, course with lots of grip
- Lots of bends so pretty even tire wear
- Much more respect for motorcycles
- Gzillions of campers and motorhomes overtaking all day!
- Low traffic volumes
- Sweeping bends with lots of visibility
- Long exposed sections very windy
- Lots of tunnels (some warm some cold) and bridges
- In the North, the Reindeer own the road!

Only rules

- If travelling with the Tour Guide, gloves on ready to go at 9am (time changes WhatsApp notification/dinner udpate)
- Dinner at 7:30pm (group updates at dinner)

Money

- Norwegian Krone ~13 = £1
- Cash is not widely used
- Biggest expense is fuel, pay at pump
- Hotel bars did not always handle cash
- Bank acct (e.g. Monzo) / Travel card with no transaction charges






